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ABSTRAK

Upaya untuk menurunkan angka AKI dan AKB aadalah denga cara menerapkan asuhan kebidanan berkelanjutan atau disebut *Continuty Of Care (COC)* dengan tujuan meningkatkan kualitas pelayanan kebidanan yang membutuhkan hubungan terus-menerus antara pasien denga tenaga profesional kesehatan. Asuhan yang diberikan kepada Ny. L usia 28 tahun dengan menerapkan manajemen *varney* meliputi : pengkajian, interprestasi data, diagnosa potensial,antisipasi/tindakan segera, perencanaan, pelaksanaan dan evaluasi. Asuhan *Continuty Of Care* pada masa kehamilan, persalinan, nifas, bayi baru lahir dan bayi serta keluarga berencana (KB) pada Ny. L usia 28 tahun P1A0 telah berhasil diberikan, dibuktikan dengan keadaan ibu dan bayi baik. Semua asuhan sudah dilaksanakan sesuai teori dan tidak ditemukan kesenjangan antara teori dan praktek lapangan.

ABSTRACT

Efforts to reduce maternal and infant mortality rates are by implementing continuous midwifery care or called Continuity Of Care (COC) with the aim of improving the quality of midwifery services that require continuous relationships between patients and health professionals. The care provided to Mrs. L aged 28 years by implementing Varney management includes: assessment, data interpretation, potential diagnosis, anticipation/immediate action, planning, implementation and evaluation. Continuity Of Care care during pregnancy, childbirth, postpartum, newborns and infants and family planning (KB) to Mrs. L aged 28 years P1A0 has been successfully provided, as evidenced by the good condition of the mother and baby. All care has been implemented according to theory and no gaps were found between theory and field practice.
